# What's accepted and Where?

## **All Sites, accept at No Charge, Recyclable Materials** such as the following:

All Rinsed Plastic Bottles, Tubs, Pails (up to 20L) and Clear Pre-Formed Plastics, Clean Plastic Shopping Bags & Sheet Plastic, Rinsed Tin Cans, Clear Rinsed Glass Bottles & Jars, Cardboard and Boxboard, Newspaper, Magazines, Phone Books, Office Paper, Tires, TVs, Computers & Printers, Microwaves, Left Over Paint, Lead Acid Batteries, Inkjet & Toner Cartridges, Ni-Cd Rechargeable Batteries, Agricultural Pesticide Containers, Oil Filters, Oil Jugs & Pails.

*Note: Used Oil is only accepted at the Boyle Landfill and at the Athabasca Transfer Site*

## **Rural Transfer Sites:** (Perryvale, Colinton, Whispering Hills, Grassland and Wandering River)

are set-up to accept solid waste from local residents within the area.

In general all sites accept the following: household waste, fixtures, furniture, scrap metal, appliances, burnable wood and small do-it-yourself construction, renovation and demolition materials.

**Transfer Sites are not set-up to accept large volumes** of commercial, construction, renovation and demolition waste.

**The Athabasca Transfer Site and Recycle Facility** is set up similar to the rural sites with the exception that it does not accept large volumes of burnable wood. **It may consider medium size loads of construction, renovation and demolition waste.** Large loads **may be re-routed to a landfill.**

**The Boyle Landfill and Recycle Site** is registered as a Class II Landfill with volume and waste type restrictions. It is set-up to accept solid waste from local residents within the area.

In general the Boyle Landfill accepts the same materials as the rural transfer sites. **This Landfill is not approved for large volumes of commercial, construction, renovation and demolition waste.**

**The Athabasca Regional Landfill** Is a registered Class II and III landfill that can accept most types of solid waste with the exception of Hazardous, Industrial or Oilfield Waste. The Landfill is approved to accept large municipal, commercial, construction, renovation, and demolition waste.

**User Fees** are collected at all Transfer Sites and Landfills to support landfill construction and operational costs including trucking and material specific processing costs. Recyclable Materials that are accepted for free are prepared for market at the Athabasca Recycle Facility and the revenues received from the sale of the materials support the handling costs.

**In efforts to maintain Low User Fees and to keep operational costs low** it is important that materials are sorted into designated areas so that they can be diverted from landfill. .

### **April 24<sup>th</sup> Household Hazardous Waste Roundup (ONE DAY ONLY)**

**Where:** Boyle Landfill 9:30am to 11:30am and at the Athabasca Transfer Site 1:00pm to 4:30pm

### **April 19<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> and September 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Appliance Roundup Weeks**

Bring your old fridges, freezers, kitchen stoves, dishwashers, microwaves, clothes washers, dryers, furnaces and hot water tanks to any site during normal operating hours.

No fees will be charged, except for appliances with freon. (fridges, freezers and AC units)

### **May 17<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> – Rural Fire Smart Program**

Clean up your yard and bring in woody debris, dead grass, leaves and small amounts of wooden construction debris free of charge to any transfer site that has a burn pit within the County of Athabasca.
